For more than a decade the Argentinean government and the judge in charge covered up the investigation about the 1994AMIA bombing in Buenos Aires in which 85 persons were killed and 151 wounded. This was the deadliest bombing in Argentinean history. Prosecutor Nisman, in charge of the Special Investigation Unit, reversed the investigation and caused Argentina to be the first country to demand, through Interpol, the capture of the Iranians accused of being the perpetrators, including Iran's the President Hashemi Rafsanjani.
