
Silence is not an option: Venezuela's Night of the Broken Synagogue Sponsored by Northeast Queens Jewish Community Council, the Kufperberg Holocaust Center and Queens Jewish Community Council





On Feb 26, a near-capacity crowd at the Hillcrest Jewish Center listened raptly to testimony about the night the main Sephardi Synagogue in Caracas, Venezuela was desecrated by 15 individuals. Destruction and anti-Semilic graffiti was the result. Former Venezuela residents **Jose** Kliksberg and Daniel Kaswan described exactly what happened and how the government decided it was just some people who wanted money.
